**Mission:** Task Force Wolverine supports the Government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan (GIROA) in the provinces of Parwan, Panjshir and Bamyan by furthering economic development, mentoring government officials, and assisting Afghan National Security Forces in order to protect the Afghan population and increase the competency, capacity and credibility of Afghan institutions.

## Assigned Units:

- **Provincial Reconstruction Teams:** Three PRTs operate in the task force area of operations. They are unique as they are civilian led, although each has a military commander that works in cooperation with the civilian director. PRTs conduct civil-military operations to assist the GIROA develop sustainable reconstruction projects, encourage responsible governance and rule of law. They also work to measure and increase the security capacity and capabilities of the Afghan National Security Forces.

- **1<sup>st</sup> Squadron, 172<sup>nd</sup> Cavalry Regiment -Task Force Morgan:** Conducts counter-insurgency operations in the Parwan province and is augmented with an engineer company, air defense company, military police platoon and a Macedonian Army platoon.
- **Kentucky Agribusiness Development Team:** Works closely with the Afghan Department of Agriculture, Irrigation and Livestock to improve agribusiness in Afghanistan. The KY ADT has the distinction of having the only veterinarian on an ADT in Afghanistan.
- **86<sup>th</sup> Brigade Special Troops Battalion:** Provides oversight of base support services for Bagram Airfield to include security, billeting, meals, transportation and Reception, Staging, Onward-movement & Integration of personnel arriving in Afghanistan.
- **Operations Coordination Center – Provincial:** Three OCC-Ps operate in the task force area of operations. One in each of the provinces of Parwan, Panjshir and Bamyan. In addition to acting as a liaison with the ANSF, the servicemembers train and mentor the Afghan National Police.

*Task Force Wolverine falls under operational control of Combined Joint Task Force – 101, the operational headquarters for [Regional Command - East](#) located at [Bagram Airfield](#). CJTF-101 is commanded by [Maj. Gen. John F. Campbell](#) of the 101st Airborne Division, based at Fort Campbell, KY. Mr. Tom Gibbons is the Senior Civilian Representative for [CJTF-101](#), serving as the U.S. Government's lead proponent for sub-national governance, stabilization and civilian-military integration at the regional level.*
